OVERVIEW: ACCESSIBILTY & AB'S US RETAIL SITE

- The site's accessibility is good (7/10)—and better than our competitors
- The semantic CSS strategy is generally strong and needs just small tweaks
 - But UX styles don't match up with CSS semantics
- The color palette has one major weakness, the light gray background color isn't accessible
 - Compliant for most color blindness
- No videos are compliant
 - Need to improve text descriptions, and include transcripts and closed-captioning on all
- The homepage carousel isn't compliant
- Most charts are compliant
 - One major exception is side-by-side charts such as Risk Management
- No graphs are compliant
 - Use HighCharts to create fully accessible graphs
- Great examples of accessible implementation include disneycruise.disney.go.com, jetblue.com, apple.com, amazon.com, target.com









Tags are unusable since there is no indication that they are interactive buttons—users will just be confused




PRODUCT SECONDARY TABS & JUMP NAV



The chart overall reads well, except it reads: Overall Morningstar Rating TM, blank—instead of reading number of stars

















HYPOTHETICAL GROWTH CHART



NAV HISTORY CHART



When the user tabs into Select, it reads as navigation with no mention of collapsed content


CAROUSEL

Currently implementation confusing on a screen reader:


- Each carousel item is a separate heading—no indication that they are in a carousel
- The carousel buttons are also read separately as 1, 2 etc
- Once in the carousel, it reads correctly that this is a list with 5 links




US RETAIL LANDING — STRUCTURE




